

Midwest Operating Engineers Retiree Welfare Plan Medicare Prescription Drug Plan

The Prescription Drug Program provides eligible retired members of Local 150, and their eligible dependents who are eligible for Medicare, benefits through the Midwest Operating Engineers Retiree Welfare Plan Medicare Prescription Drug Plan (RWP Medicare PDP). We are proudly partnered with OptumRx to provide you, and your family, all your pharmaceutical needs.

The RWP Medicare PDP combines a standard Medicare Part D prescription drug plan with additional coverage provided by the RWP. This additional coverage is also referred to as a wrap plan because it wraps around the standard Medicare Part D plan and closes the gaps between Part D and your pre-Medicare coverage from the Prescription Drug Program. This means that you will have more coverage than the standard Medicare Part D plan.

Enrollment

Enrollment into the RWP Medicare PDP is automatic if the Fund Office has your Medicare Number. It is critical that you provide the Fund Office with your Medicare Number and a copy of your Medicare card once you are enrolled into Medicare. We cannot enroll you into the RWP Medicare PDP if we do not have your Medicare Number. Once enrolled, you will receive a Welcome Letter with the effective date of your RWP Medicare PDP coverage. This letter will also contain a new OptumRx MedicareRx ID card that contains your own unique ID number. Please do not present this new card until on or after your effective date. The OptumRx MedicareRx ID card contains your unique ID number so it should not be used by your covered dependents.

Filling a Prescription

Option 1: Fill your prescription at your local retail pharmacy.

- The plan allows you to receive a 30-day supply or up to a 90-day supply of prescription medication at any OptumRx network pharmacy. Just be sure to present your OptumRx MedicareRx ID card at your network pharmacy so your prescriptions are accurately billed. **Please note:** You are no longer required to fill a 90-day supply of your maintenance medications. Also, you are no longer required to use CVS only to fill your maintenance medications.

To find a list of the OptumRx network pharmacies, you can visit the OptumRx website at www.optumrx.com and use the "Pharmacy Locator" tool (found under the "Member Tools" tab). You can also call OptumRx Member Services at 866-868-2493 for help or to request a copy of the list to be mailed to you.

Option 2: Fill your prescription with Home Delivery (prescription mail-order service).

- The plan also allows you to receive long-term maintenance medications through Home Delivery.

Our Plan's Formulary and Wrap Plan

The RWP Medicare PDP Drug Formulary list is an almost complete list of medications covered by our plan. You can view/print this list by visiting the Prescription Drug Program page at www.moefunds.com.

If your medication is not listed, please call OptumRx Member Services at 866-868-2493 to find out if your medication is covered through the Formulary or the wrap coverage provided by the RWP.

Ask your physician to consider prescribing generic medication as a first line option, when medically appropriate, from the RWP Medicare PDP comprehensive formulary list. Generic medications are typically a lower cost to the plan, and these

savings are immediately passed directly to the membership. If there is no generic available, there may be a preferred brand name medication listed.

The wrap plan offers additional coverage for some prescription drugs not normally covered under Medicare Part D, such as medications used for anorexia, weight loss or weight gain, medications used for the symptomatic relief of cough or cold, prescription vitamins and mineral products not covered by Part D, and medications used for the treatment of sexual or erectile dysfunction.

Copayments

Each time you pick up a medication you are responsible for a copay as outlined in the chart below.

Covered Prescription Drugs	Retail Pharmacy (up to a 30-day supply)	Retail Pharmacy (up to a 90-day supply)	Home Delivery Pharmacy (up to a 90-day supply)
Tier 1- Generic Drugs	\$5	\$15	\$15
Tier 2- Preferred Brand Drugs	\$10	\$30	\$30
Tier 3- Non-Preferred Brand Drugs	\$25	\$45	\$45
Tier 4- Specialty/High-Cost Drugs*	\$100	N/A	\$100
* Specialty/High-Cost Drugs are defined by Medicare as medications with a cost of \$670 or more for up to a 30-day maximum supply.			

Billing Information

It is imperative that you present your OptumRx MedicareRx ID card each time you pick up a prescription, so your medications are billed accurately. Everyone enrolled into the RWP Medicare PDP will receive their own ID card. **It is important that everyone uses their own ID card when filling their prescriptions.**

The required billing information is: **RxBIN:** 610011 **RxGRP:** EGWPS045 **RxPCN:** CTRXMEDD

Member's, spouse's and/or dependent's in the RWP that are **NOT** eligible for Medicare should use their MOE vendor ID card to fill prescriptions.

Utilization Management

Some covered medications may require a Prior Authorization, Quantity Limits or Step Therapy. To find out if your medication has any additional requirements or limits, refer to the Comprehensive Formulary.
