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

Within the past six months and continuing to date, IUOE Local 150, by its officers, agents, and representatives, has engaged in, and has induced or encouraged, individuals employed by Central Contracting Services, Inc. and other persons engaged in commerce or in an industry affecting commerce to engage in a strike or a refusal in the course of their employment to use, manufacture, process, transport or otherwise handle or work on goods, articles, materials, or commodities or to perform services, and has threatened, coerced, and restrained Central Contracting Services, Inc. and other persons engaged in commerce or in an industry affecting commerce where an object thereof is to force or require Central Contracting Services, Inc. to assign crane erection work at the RPM construction site in Chicago, Illinois and on other projects to employees who are members of or represented by IUOE Local 150, a labor organization, rather than to employees who are members of or represented by Iron Workers Local 1, a labor organization.
