



Midwest Operating Engineers Prescription Drug Program Compounded Medications

Compounding is the preparation of a personalized medication by combining, mixing, or altering ingredients to meet a patient's specific medical needs as prescribed by a physician. The Midwest Operating Engineers Prescription Drug Program has established guidelines to ensure that compounded medication claims are processed in accordance with Plan provisions.

Requirements for Coverage

All of the following conditions must be met for coverage:

1. Ingredient Coverage

The compounded medication must contain at least one ingredient covered under the Plan.

2. In-Network Pharmacy

Must be filled at an in-network pharmacy.

3. Cost and Prior Authorization (PA)

If the total cost exceeds \$300, the prescriber must submit a PA request to CVS Caremark for review.

Billing Instructions

The pharmacy should process the claim using the billing information on your MOE vendor ID card, including the RxBin, RxPCN, RxGroup, and ID number required for processing. You can access your MOE vendor ID card electronically through your My150 account dashboard.

The only exception is if the pharmacy cannot bill insurance. In that case, you may request the pharmacy provide a **Universal Claim Form for a Compounded Medication**.

- Submit the completed form and register receipt to the MOE Pharmacy Benefit Department for consideration of reimbursement, provided all coverage requirements above are met.
